

## About Karen Mason

Karen Mason has starred on Broadway, Off-Broadway, television, and recording and "has few peers when it comes to ripping the roof off with her amazing voice that knows no bounds!" (TheatreScene.net) The recipient of the 2019 MAC Lifetime Achievement Award, she is a 14-time MAC Award winner and has won the MAC Award for Major Female Vocalist of the Year for six consecutive years. Her highly acclaimed recordings include her newest single, "Let The Music Play." She has also won the 2006 Nightlife Award for Major Female Vocalist and has three Bistro Awards.

### **THEATER**

Karen starred in **CHASING RAINBOWS: THE ROAD TO OZ** at Papermill Playhouse as Kay Koverman. She starred in the North American premiere tour of Andrew Lloyd Webber's **LOVE NEVER DIES**, playing Madame Giry to standing ovations.

On Broadway, she garnered rave reviews starring as The Queen of Hearts in **WONDERLAND** and she originated the role of Tanya in Abba's **MAMMA MIA!** For her portrayal of Tanya, Ms. Mason was awarded a 2002 Drama Desk nomination as Best Actress. Her other leading roles include Norma Desmond in **SUNSET BOULEVARD** as Standby to Glenn Close, Betty Buckley, and Elaine Paige, which she performed to critical acclaim and standing ovations on Broadway and in Los Angeles for three years; Velma von Tussel in the final Broadway company of **HAIRSPRAY**; "Monotony" singer, Mazeppa in **JEROME ROBBINS' BROADWAY**; Rosalie in **CARNIVAL** (another Drama Desk nomination); plus featured roles in Broadway's **TORCH SONG TRILOGY**; and **PLAY ME A COUNTRY SONG**.

Karen won the Outer Critics Circle Award for her performance in **AND THE WORLD GOES 'ROUND**, and starred Off-Broadway in her own show **KAREN MASON SINGS BROADWAY, BEATLES AND BRIAN**. In New York, Karen starred in one-woman musical about Dorothy Parker **YOU MIGHT AS WELL LIVE** and her autobiographical one-woman show, **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**.

Karen has given concerts in the United Kingdom, Sweden, Brazil, Scotland, Tokyo and Osaka. Her starring symphonic performances include The Long Beach Symphony Orchestra with Maestro Michael Berkowitz, The Philly Pops with Peter Nero, The New York Pops with Skitch Henderson, The Oklahoma Philharmonic with Joel Levine, the premier performance of The Chicagoland Pops, The Indianapolis Philharmonic, and the St. Louis Symphony John McDaniel.
